ADMINISTRATOR'S STATEMENT

979 South Plains College

South Plains Junior College District endorses the \$1.968 billion request, per the TACC letter to the LBB dated July 16,2012, for student success funding for the 2014-2015 biennium. Funding for community colleges should be appropriated through three strategies: Core Operations, Student Success Points, and Contact Hour Funding. During the last two biennuims, educational appropriations per FTE student at South Plains College have dropped fifteen(15) percent. During that same period, contact hours at South Plains College have increased eleven(11) percent. The college has had to look to local funds, primarily tuition and fees, to offset this funding shortfall. Also, the prospects of decreased federal funding in the future further compounds the problem. These funding shortfalls make it impossible for South Plains College to meet the CLOSING THE GAPS requirements mandated by the legislature. As higher education becomes less affordable, fewer Texans, many of whom are the first in their families to attend college, will receive the training necessary to function in today's economy. At best South Plains College was always two(2) years behind in funding growth through state appropriations. If funding is cut in the next biennium, the college will be six(6)years behind. If the Legislature expects higher education, particularly the community colleges, to meet CLOSING THE GAPS requirements, additional funding, not less, is imperative. Unless the current trend of decreasing appropriations is reversed, there will be devestating consquences to the economy and the State of Texas as a whole.
