DUAL CREDIT

WHAT IS DUAL CREDIT?

Dual credit is a partnership between South Plains College and area high schools. This program allows students to receive college credit for courses taken while in high school. SPC is able to offer these dual credit courses to high school students at a discounted rate.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Students who are in TSI compliance, have permission from their high school principal and have met South Plains College admission requirements are eligible to enroll in dual credit courses.

HOW DO I APPLY?

To apply for admission to South Plains College the following documents must be complete and on file in the Admissions and Records Office before you will be allowed to register:

REGISTRATION
