The South Plains College Scholarship Scramble is an annual event to support student scholarships at South Plains College. Join us to raise funds for the SPC Founder's Opportunity Scholarship Endowment.

## Tournament Location and Format

Scheduled for June 6, 2016, the tournament will be a four-person scramble shotgun start event. Men's, women's and mixed foursomes are welcome. Entry will be limited to the first 32 teams (128 golfers). The event will be located at the Lubbock Country Club, 3400 Mesa Rd. The 6,523-yard, par 72 course is a hilly, tree-lined course with spectacular views.

Awards ceremony, door prizes, raffle drawing and heavy refreshments follow the round.

## Dress

Standard golf attire is required. Collared shirt. No denim. Soft spikes only.

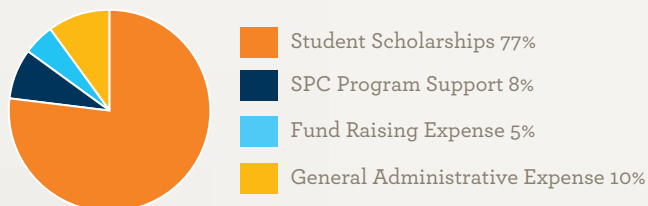
## Scholarships at South Plains College
