Project #4 - EDIT

Only the first student. In the desktop, double click the Avid Media Composer icon, if it has not all ready been selected. You must also select the Fest Project in the Select Project folder and click OK.

- On the top right of the Timeline is a tab. If it shows DNA, click on it, so it reads 1394. Also turn on cap lock.
- In the Fest Bin, right click the mouse below the clips and select new sequence.
- In the bin folder the untitled sequence that is highlighted, type your section number and last name.
- In the Fest Bin, double click on the Leader clip. Click the overwrite tab () or B.
- Double click on your section number clip. At the bottom click at the beginning of its Timeline. Press Play (L) and find where the student starts saying the first word of the sentence, Mark-In (I). Listen to the audio and when you hear the last word of the sentence, Mark-Out (O). Press Q, then 6 and listen to what you have marked. If you need to backup a couple of frames, press the number 3 key to a couple of frame before the first word, Mark-In (I). Go a couple of frames past the last word, Mark-Out (O). Click the overwrite tab () or B.
- Repeat the previous step for the remaining 13 sentences.
- Return the blue vertical line on the Timeline to the beginning of the sentences by holding down the control key and click near the beginning of the sentences.
- Turn off tracks V1. In the Fest Bin, double click on the Music clip.
- Create two new audio tracks. In the Timeline right click the mouse and select New Audio Track twice. Place the mouse cursor on the far left A1 Tab and hold down the left button and drag it to the new A3 Tab in the Timeline. Next, place the mouse cursor on the far left A2 Tab and hold down the left button and drag it to the new A4 Tab in the Timeline.
- Click the overwrite tab () or B.
- Turn off tracks A3 and A4. In the Fest Bin, double click on the Country Fest clip and go to the beginning of the timeline, Mark-In. Create 5 seconds & no frames, Mark-Out.
- Create a new video track. In the Timeline right click the mouse and select New Video Track. Place the mouse cursor on the far left V1 Tab and hold down the left button and drag it to the new V2 Tab in the Timeline.
- Drag the blue vertical line on the Timeline to where you hear Country Fest in the sentences, Pause (K). Backup a couple of frames.
- Click the overwrite tab. Click on the G key to remove the in and out points.
- Repeat the previous two steps for Rock Fest. R & B Fest, Thursday Nite live and Bluegrass Fest.
