The assessment should include taking and recording vital signs, a review of all systems (neuro, cardiovascular, pulmonary, gastrointestinal, genitourinary), and noting all IVs, tubes, drains, and invasive hemodynamic monitoring.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. Review all charts, including patient's chart, diagnosis, treatment, progress notes, and nurse's notes.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Observe complications of acute myocardial infarction.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. After observation and instruction, draw blood samples via venipuncture or existing IV and arterial lines.
