

Homework Procedure

1. Each homework assignment should be performed separately.
2. Each homework assignment should have the following labeling pattern at the top of the first page:

Homework #1; 1.3 Operations with Real Numbers
p. 22; problems 1, 5, 8, 10, and 15-20

3. Each problem should be **clearly** labeled.
 - a. Example:

(1.) problem

work for problem

answer

(2.) problem

work for problem

answer

4. All pages of homework required for sub missal must not have any frayed spiral edges. If homework was performed in a notebook then homework maybe torn out but submitted to the notebook only if the frayed spiral edges are trimmed.
5. A pencil is highly and strongly advised when performing homework but not required.
