1. Apply for Admissions

2. Take a Placement Test

Students enrolling in college level courses should take a placement test before registering for classes. South Plains College offers the approved statewide exam called TSI Assessment. Scores form the TSI Assessment are used for advisement and placement of students in appropriate coursework.

A student is exempt from taking a placement test if he/she scores well enough on the ACT, SAT or TAKS test. Visit with your high school counselor to find out if you are exempt.

3. Apply for Financial Aid
