

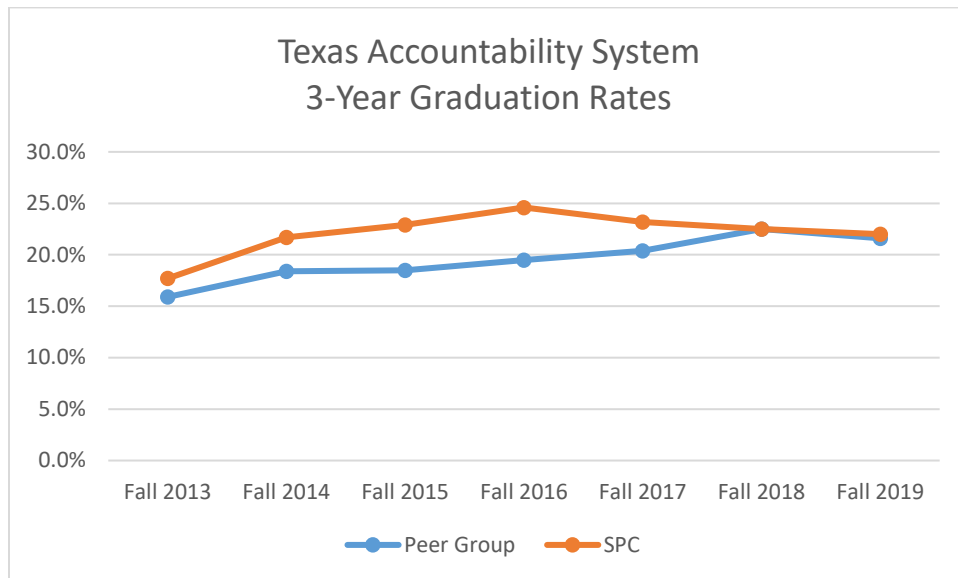

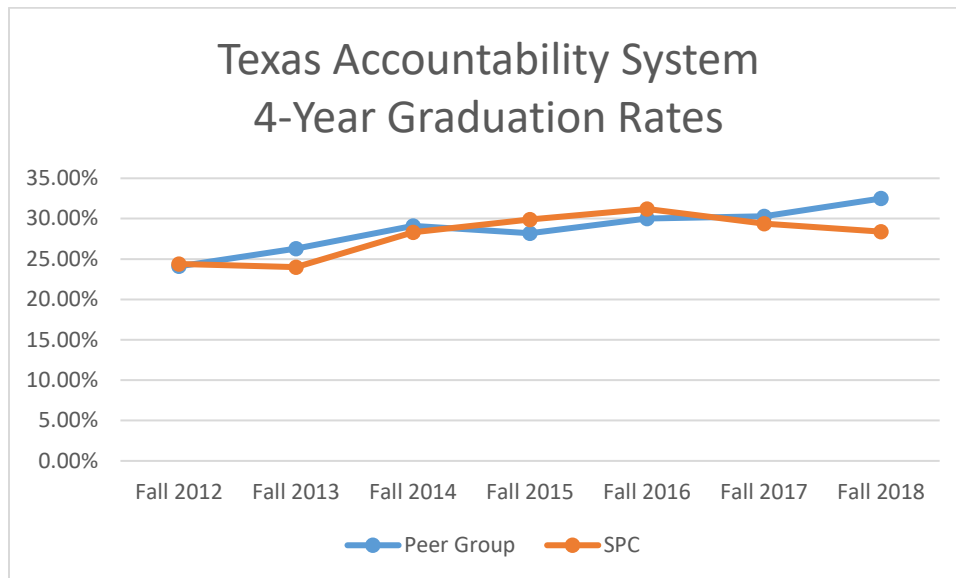

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## Length of Time to Degree

Within SPC’s defined peer group, SPC falls in the middle of the average time to a degree for the data reported in 2021. The maximum threshold is 4.5 years. SPC faculty, administration and staff have established a target goal of 3.5 years by 2025 as the average amount of time to a degree.
