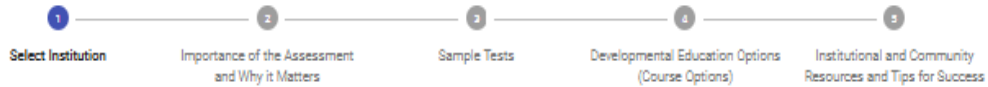

### ACCUPLACER

ACCUPLACER measures key skills needed for academic and workforce success. ACCUPLACER reading, writing, and mathematics test scores are used to inform college placement decisions and to identify where students are likely to be positioned or likely to succeed within a postsecondary course framework.



### English as a Second Language (ESL)

ACCUPLACER ESL helps place English learners in appropriate language courses. Developed as an assessment tool for ESL students and English as a foreign language (EFL) students, it consists of five components: Sentence Meaning, Language Use, Reading Skills, Listening, and WritePlacer ESL.

### Texas Success Initiative Assessments 2.0 (TSIA 2)
