
About the South Plains College Foundation

Tournament Location and Format

Scheduled for June 7, 2021, the tournament is a four-person scramble shotgun start event. Men's, women's and mixed foursomes are welcome. Entry is limited to the first 32 teams (128 golfers). The event is located at the Lubbock Country Club, 3400 Mesa Rd. The 6,523-yard, par 72 course is a hilly, tree-lined private course with spectacular views.
