College: Public, two-year community college serving 13,000+ students

Faculty: More than 80 percent of faculty have earned master's or doctorate degrees in their field.
The student-faculty ratio is 21:1.

Academic Programs: The Arts and Sciences Division is comprised of 10 academic departments and 42 suggested transfer disciplines, providing a smooth transition to university baccalaureate programs.

Technical Programs: The Technical Division offers 64 individual one and two-year programs of study.

Health Occupations Division: The Health Occupations Division offers nine programs of study.

On-campus Housing: 12 residence halls on the Levelland campus housing 796 students




