Evaluation of course credit earned at other institutions by the LCU Transfer Evaluation Office does not decree approval of the credit for use toward degree requirements. Only the academic dean of the college offering the program in which a student is enrolled has authority for determining which courses will be applied toward any specific program. LCU accepts and gives credit for all courses to be transferred from South Plains College, providing the grade received is a C or higher. We cannot however, grant credit for technical or intermediate/remedial classes. Financial aid is available at LCU and more particularly, academic scholarships are given for a cumulative grade point average of 2.7 or higher.
