LCU accepts and gives credit for all courses to be transferred from South Plains College, providing the grade received is a C or higher. We cannot however, grant credit for technical or intermediate/remedial classes. Financial aid is available at LCU and more particularly, academic scholarships are given for a cumulative grade point average of 2.7 or higher.
